

NEW YORK SUSTAINABLE ENERGY CONFERENCE AND TRADE SHOW
Exhibit Rules and Regulations

These rules and regulations are part of the Exhibit Space Agreement for The New York Sustainable Energy Conference and Trade Show (the "Show") developed and sponsored and by Grassroots Environmental Education, Inc., a non-profit organization ("Grassroots").

The purpose of the Show is to promote renewable and sustainable energy systems and equipment to replace or augment those which rely on any type of fossil fuel. All exhibits must be in harmony with the goals of the Show. Grassroots reserves the right to reject any exhibit or portion thereof which, in the sole discretion of Grassroots, does not conform with the purposes of the Show.

LIABILITY: Neither Grassroots nor its representatives, employees or agents, specifically including the Tarrytown Doubletree Hotel ("Hotel") shall be responsible for any injury, loss or damage that may occur to the Exhibitor or Exhibitor's employees or property from any cause whatsoever including, but not limited to claims based in contracts, negligence, strict liability, or other sort. In no event shall the above mentioned be liable for any incidental or consequential damages, including any liability for failure to perform its obligations hereunder due to strikes, riots, acts of God, or any other act, circumstance, occurrence or cause beyond their control.

INDEMNIFICATION: In consideration of the mutual covenants contained herein, Exhibitor hereby agrees and shall indemnify and hold harmless Grassroots and/or Hotel, their representatives, employees, and agents, against all suits, claims, actions, losses, costs, penalties, and damages, or whatsoever kind and nature, including attorneys fees, arising out of, in connection with, or incident to the Exhibitor's participation in the Show

CARE OF THE BUILDING AND EQUIPMENT: Exhibitors must not injure or deface the walls or floors of the building and adjacent areas, including outside surfaces. If such damage appears, the Exhibitor is liable for the property so damaged. Exhibitor assumes total responsibility and liability for any and all damage due, related, or pertaining to, or caused by loading and unloading of equipment or any exhibit materials utilized by the Exhibitor.

DISPLAY AREA: All booth spaces shall be approximately 100 square feet; tabletops shall be approximately 48 square feet. Booths and tabletops are assigned on a first come, first served basis. No assignment of booth space will be made without payment. All exhibits must be confined within the area of the space designated by Grassroots.

FIRE AND SAFETY RULES AND REGULATIONS: Combustible exhibit and display materials must be flame-proofed. Explosive materials are not allowed on the premises. All exhibits must meet local fire marshal's specifications and existing fire code requirements. All electrical wiring must conform to local electrical codes.

SALES: Exhibitors are encouraged to offer special incentives to Show attendees and orders may be taken at the show. However, no cash sales of merchandise are permitted on the Show floor.

EXHIBIT AGREEMENT: Exhibitor will not be allowed to exhibit or display material unless they have executed the Exhibit Space Rental Agreement and returned the original copy with payment in full to Grassroots before the show.

These rules, regulations, and conditions have been drawn for the purpose and intention of providing a well balanced, well regulated, attractive, and successful trade show and exhibition. Grassroots and/or Hotel management shall have full power to so interpret the rules and regulations or make such and any and all amendments of the foregoing rules, regulations, and conditions which shall bind the Exhibitors.
