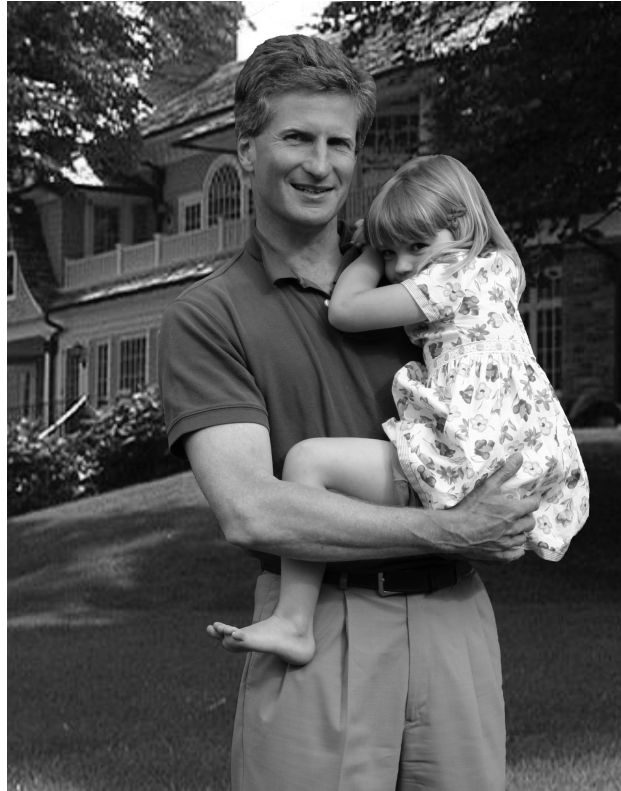


I've got one great reason not to use pesticides on my lawn.
